MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE ZION CITY COUNCIL
HELD ON TUESDAY, MAY 28, 2002, AT 6:02 P.M. IN THE CITY
COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, ZION, ILLINOIS

Mayor Harrison called the meeting to order.

On call of the roll the following answered present: Commissioners Bennett, Rogers, DeTienne and Mayor Harrison. Commissioner Taylor was absent.

ROAD IMPROVEMENTS

Mayor Harrison announced that it is necessary to defer the first reading of an ordinance authorizing and providing for the issuance of \$8,000,000 Taxable General Obligation Bonds (Combined Zion Energy LLC Agreement Fees and Motor Fuel Tax Receipts Alternate Revenue Source) until the next regular Council meeting on June 4, in order to finalize the necessary documents.

SHERIDAN ROAD STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS

Mayor Harrison announced that it is necessary to defer the first reading of an ordinance authorizing and providing for the issuance of \$6,000,000 Taxable General Obligation Bonds (Special Tax Allocation Fund Alternate Revenue Source) until the next regular Council meeting on June 4, in order to finalize the necessary documents.

EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE

Commissioner Bennett presented a proposed timeline regarding the City's employee health insurance. The insurance committee and the insurance consultant will be developing recommended changes for the Council's review, hoping to implement any changes January 1, 2003. Meetings will be scheduled with Fire and Police union representatives, as well as non-union employees, to discuss health insurance. Commissioner Bennett stated the main goals are to improve service and reduce costs.
