1. Remove multi-family designation along lakefront and replace with 90% recreational and 10% retail designation.

A. Route 173 Corridor

- 1. Reduce the amount multifamily designation by 25% and change it to Commercial
- 2. Designate 75% of multifamily as senior housing (55 and older)
