Request: Seeking a Variance from Section 102- 206(b)(2) of the Zion Municipal Code to continue single family use for the property located at 2273 Galilee Avenue.

2272 Galilee is in a local business district, but the 2200 block is predominantly residential, with local business zones nearby on the 2100 block and near Salem Food Mark. The property is requesting a variance to continue its senior-friendly use within the selling district.

Commissioner Heffelman asked if the property is for rent or for sale. Director Ianson said it is for sale. Commissioner Quinn asked if there saw only one house on the lot. Director Ianson said yes.
