### Process

# Preparatory Training

Age 21 at time of hire

- Under age 35 at time of hire unless already in Illinois Pension system
- US Citizen
- Illinois Department of Public Health(IDPH)
  EMT-Paramedic at time of hire
- No felony convictions
- High school diploma/GED
- CPAT (Candidate

Physical Ability Test)

- Preference points awarded for:
  - Illinois OSFM Firefighter 2/Basic
  - Associate's, Bachelor's degree
  - Military Service
  - FAE
  - Previous firefighter experience of 2 years

All hiring by the Zion Fire Rescue Department is done from an eligibility list created by the Board of Fire and Police Commission. As positions become available, hiring is done in order of placement on the list.

An eligibility list lasts for (2) years from date of posting, and the testing process is held every other year. Creation of an eligibility list consists of the following steps:

- Announcement of testing process
- Application period
- Written Test
- Oral Interview
- Posting of list

The process typically takes 6+ months from start to finish
