All Applicants Must Meet the Following Minimum Requirements to Apply:

- At least 21 years of age, not to exceed the age of 35, at time of application;
- U.S. Citizen;
- High school graduate or GED equivalent;
- Possess a valid driver's license with good driving record;
- Successfully complete the P.O.W.E.R Test conducted through any of the following testing centers: Northeastern Illinois Public Safety Training Academy (NIPSTA) www.NIPSTA.org -OR- Joliet Junior College <https://www.jjc.edu/about-jjc/places-interest/power-testing> -OR- Triton Community College <http://www.triton.edu/POWER/>. A POWER test card must be dated within 9 months **PRIOR** to the application deadline date (September 13, 2021) and submitted with application.

All Applicants Moving Forward In the Process Must Meet the Following:

- Successfully pass a written test with a score at or above 70%;
- Successfully complete an oral interview;
- Successfully complete a background investigation:
 - *Applicants will be required to fully disclose all personnel matters, to include agreements and sealed files and submit to fingerprinting if required;*
- Successfully complete a psychological evaluation;
- Successfully complete a medical physical, including drug and alcohol screening;
- **Pay a \$45.00 non-refundable application processing fee;**
- **Application deadline:** Monday, September 13, 2021 at 4:00 pm;
- **Complete mandatory on-line written examination testing:** Thursday, September 23, 2021 at 7:00 AM through Friday, September 24, 2021 at 7:00 AM.
