Lateral Transfer Applicants

Minimum Requirements:

- Be a United States citizen and Possess a Valid Driver's License
- Have been employed, whether currently or within the past 2 years as a fulltime, sworn law enforcement officer by a Federal, State, County or local law enforcement agency in which they served. Applicants must be in good standing with the agency in which they served. (Part-time certification as a law enforcement officer does not meet this requirement)
- The ability to furnish along with their application: a copy of Birth Certificate, High School Diploma or G.E.D. Certificate, and a copy of their certificate attesting to their successful completion of the Minimum Standards Basic Law Enforcement Training Course, as provided in the Illinois Police Training Act. If applicable, the applicant shall furnish any Military Service Records, including Discharge Papers (DD Form 214), a certified copy of their associate or bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university if held by the applicant.
